ORIGIN AND NATURE OF THE ROCKS OF THE VINEYARD SERIES. The only hypothesis which affords any satisfactory way out of the above-described perplexity is the following: We must suppose that the Vineyard section is not a normal, stratified deposit at all, but that it belongs to the important class of cross-bedded deposits, such as are formed by continuously acting and strong currents. In this particular case the deposits were formed at the mouth of a great river. The beds seen in the great section at Gay Head, and probably all those in Chilmark and Tisbury as well, were deposited in succession upon the advancing border of the delta of that stream....



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
