The Iraq war of 2003 and the terrorist attack of September 11, 2001 have led to heightened concern about energy security, the vulnerability of energy infrastructure, and the need for alternative fuels. Further, the 2001 electricity shortages in California brought a new emphasis to the role that renewable energy may play in electricity supply. In the 108th Congress, debate over renewable energy programs is focusing on tax credits, incentives, budget, and provisions of the omnibus energy policy bill, H.R. 6. Also, worldwide emphasis on environmental problems of air and water pollution and global climate change, and the related development of clean energy technologies in western Europe and Japan, may remain important influences on renewable energy policymaking. Concern about technology competitiveness may also be a factor in debate. For DOE's FY2003 Renewable Energy Program, the Bush Administration sought \$407.0 million.
