Found near Falestrina in 1774. Now in the Museo Kircheriuno, Itoim: Argonauts in Bithynia, and the victory of Polydeuees over King Amyous. It was executed, we are told, by Novius Plautius in the third century B.C., and undoubtedly betrays Greek influence (Eng. 7). Roman.
