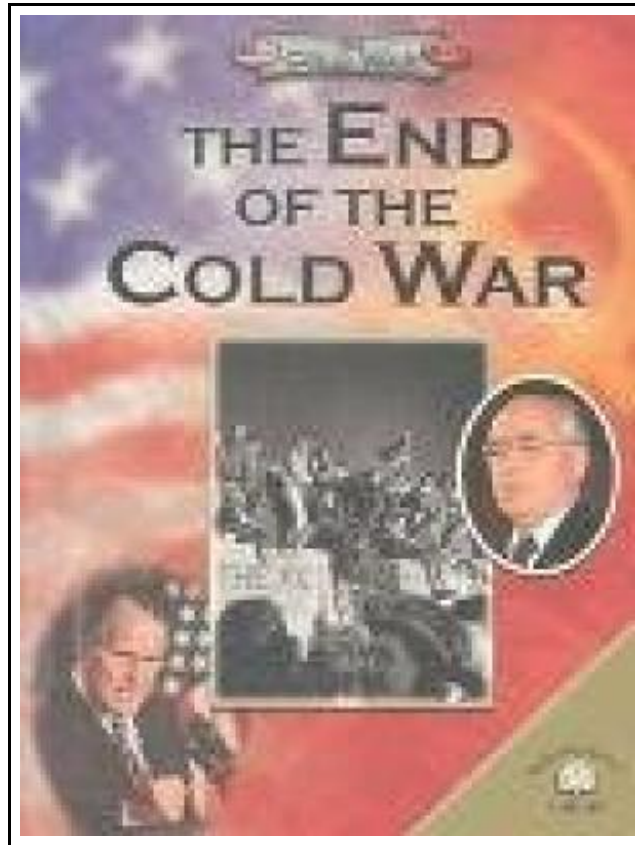

Additionally, Ms. Hatt offers some closing thoughts regarding the political future of our world as we move into an age when the potentially disastrous but predictable power bases of the Cold War years no longer exist.
